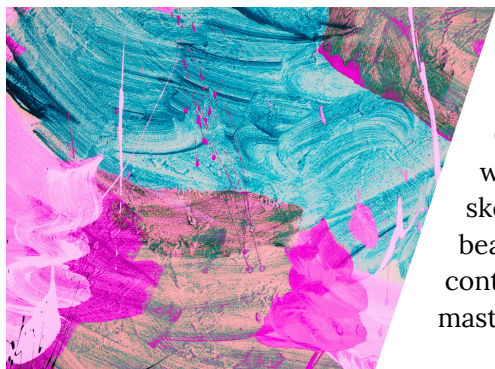

Cooking: SALADS

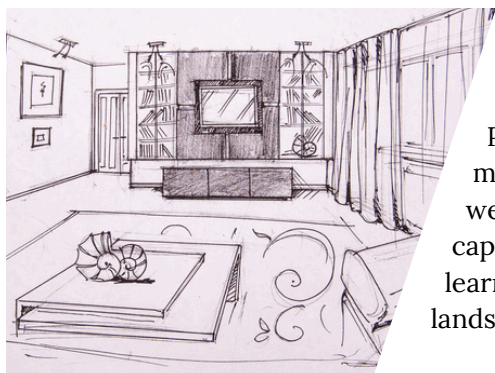
THE MENU: Tabbouleh, Cobb Salad, Coleslaw & Fruit Salad with Jello, Tex-Mex Salad
