WEEK 1

Friday Field Trip: The Bubble

STEM Explorers: Students will be introduced to STEM and its components—Science, Tech, Engineering, and Math. Activities include making Bedroom planetariums, Lava lamps, and 3D color wheels!

WEEK 3

Friday Field Trip: Archers Arena

Soccer: Campers will learn essential soccer skills such as dribbling, passing, strategizing, and shooting. Led by passionate coaches, our soccer sessions emphasize skill development, tactical training, and a love for soccer.

Hip-Hop: Pop and Lock! Whether campers try choreography or freestyling, our hip-hop program will have them breaking it down in style!

WEEK 4

Friday Field Trip: Treetop Trekking

UC DISCOVERY CAMP

Summer Camp designed
for Ages 3 to 6!



UC Discovery Camp is geared towards children aged 3 to 6, and it offers a variety of unique, fun-filled experiences in a safe, loving setting. Campers are divided into age groups and supervised by a qualified childcare provider and an assistant. Every day, campers will engage in morning and afternoon activities such as French, Science, Art, Music, Technology, and Gym, with field trips or a special guest visit scheduled on Fridays. We offer Junior Discovery Camp for ages 2.5 to 3, and Senior Discovery Camp for ages 4 to 6.

Please note: all children must be of specified ages as of June 30th, 2024.

To register for the Discovery Camp, please submit a registration form online and a cash or cheque payment to the Casa office by **June 1st, 2024**. Payment for Junior Discovery Camp should be made at the Pre/Jr Casa office. Due to limited spaces, enrollment will be on a first-come, first-served basis.

FRENCH

Campers will be exposed to the integrated AIM French Teaching Method, which teaches the French language via action-based activities in theatre, dance, and music.

TECHNOLOGY

Campers have the opportunity to enjoy learning via the use of technology. Various engaging, interactive, and instructive software/apps stimulate campers' imaginations while assisting in developing their technical abilities.

MUSIC

Campers will also be introduced to the fundamental aspects of music, such as rhythm, melody, dynamics, phrasing, and form, through activities like singing, dancing, and playing simple Orff instruments.

GYM & ACTIVITIES

Campers will engage in exciting gross motor activities such as sports and gymnastics. They will build healthy attitudes and learn to work together while being physically active.

Campers will also participate in specialized activities ranging from acquiring life skills like cooking and sewing to learning healthy living activities like dancing and yoga in our specialty room.
