

Expectations

UMS high school is inspected by the Ministry of Education, and our curriculum complies with Ontario high school expectations. As such, students must have excellent attendance and must achieve a passing grade in order to receive a credit. Proof of pre-requisite for senior courses (if required) must be submitted before July.

Enrolment

We will notify all students who have applied through our admissions portal by email, and entrance will be based on a first come, first served basis. Once your child has officially been accepted into our summer credit program, you must submit your course fee in order to secure your space. Course availability is dependent upon enrolment.

Location

Our courses are being offered in a hybrid model where students can choose to learn either <u>in person or online</u>. Students are welcome to sign up for the format of learning they prefer and will have the flexibility to change their learning format if necessary. In person classes will take place at our Main Campus, located at 4486 16th Avenue, Markham, ON. Heightened safety protocols will be in place for all students who are attending in person.

Uniforms

Students will not be required to wear uniforms during the summer months, but are required to dress appropriately for school.

Cost

\$600 per course for local students. Additionally, as a special offer, the first five students to register for a course and complete payment will qualify for a 25% discount on the course fee.

There is an additional administration fee of \$200 for international students, who must also provide a valid student visa in order to be registered for a credit.

Textbooks must be purchased by the student. Additional information will be provided upon enrolment.

Class Size

Limited to 15 students per class. A minimum of 5 students are required for a course to run.
